



Royalty Guidelines and Agreement

As a member of the Moxee Royal Court, I and my parent(s) or guardian(s), agree to the following:

1. I agree to place myself under the authority of the East Valley Community Enhancement Association (EVCEA) (as represented by the Royal Coordinator, and/or an appointed chaperone, and/or the head of the float crew), and to abide by their decisions and the guidelines.
2. I understand that scheduled obligations include organizing and participating in 50 hours of community service, personal appearances at pageants, parades, fairs, festivals, community parties and other events.
3. I agree to fulfill all scheduled obligations and appearances unless I have prearranged my absence with the Royalty Coordinator. I will give the Royalty Coordinator a minimum of 48 hours advance notice for a prearranged absence.
4. I agree to give the Royalty Coordinator as much notice as possible if I am unable to attend a scheduled function due to personal illness or family emergency so arrangements may be made for my replacement.
5. I agree to be on time for all functions.
6. I understand that unexcused absences from three functions will be sufficient cause for dismissal from the Court and forfeiture of my prize money, official clothing, sash and crown.
7. I understand that final dismissal will be by action of the EVCEA upon recommendation by the Royalty Coordinator.
8. I understand that friends, boy/girlfriends and most family members WILL NOT be permitted to accompany me during official functions when my sash and crown are being worn.
9. I understand that during travel to and from functions outside of Moxee, I am to be chaperoned by the Royalty Coordinator, an appointed chaperone, or one of my parents, and that an agreement must be made between one of my parents and the Royalty Coordinator in order for me to travel otherwise. Most travel will be by parents' participation as we do not have an official van for Royalty.
10. I understand that the Royal Court and their parents are responsible for assisting the float crew in keeping the float and trailer in good condition for parades.
11. I understand that friends, boy/girlfriends, sisters, brothers or other persons under the age of 21 may NOT drive or ride in/on the parade vehicles without permission of your advisor. This is an insurance issue and in most parades not allowed. Parent participation is encouraged.

12. I understand that if we are not using the float for parades but other vehicles, fire trucks, etc. that the owner is very particular about this vehicle. Be very careful when around the exterior surface (the paint). Also remove your shoes to step in the seats and use caution when sitting in the area the convertible top is folded into. Ask the owner if and how you can attach a sign.
13. I understand that I am responsible for any expenses I incur while traveling with the Royal Court, unless otherwise specified.
14. I agree that it is my responsibility to keep my official clothing of the Royal Court clean, pressed and in good condition.
15. I agree that official clothing of the Royal Court may be worn ONLY for official functions and these items will become my property only at the end of my reign. I further agree that if I am dismissed from the Royal Court for any reason, that all official clothing, including sashes and crowns, must be returned to the Royalty Coordinator with in 24 hours.
16. I agree not to enter any other pageants during my reign without permission of the EVCEA. I understand that the prize money will be given to me 2 to 4 weeks after coronation and that I will sign documentation that I have received the monies and that will be given to the Royalty Coordinator. Then given to the EVCEA Treasurer. ***A candidate must sell at least \$500.00 in tickets to be eligible to receive any percent of her ticket sales.***
17. I understand that I must be registered in a school of higher education during my reign and that withdrawal from school and/or expulsion will result in a mandatory resignation from the Moxee Hop Festival Royalty. You will return your tiara, sash, trophy and any other Festival properties to the EVCEA.
18. I am attaching a copy of my current grades that show that I am currently carrying a 2.5 or higher grade point average and a letter of recommendation from a teacher.
19. I agree that any visible body piercing, (ie. Eyebrows, Lips, Labrets, Nose, Cheeks, Industrial Ear) will not be allowed to be worn with official clothing with the exception of ear lobes and limited to two earrings and that no gauging is allowed.
20. I agree that any tattoos I may have will not be visible at any official functions.
21. I agree that I will not have any visible cleavage at any official function.
22. No non-family public display of affection (PDA) will take place where my sash and crown are worn.
23. I understand that my signing this agreement that I have not been pregnant nor will I become pregnant, I am not currently on or using any illegal drugs, tobacco, alcohol in gang activity and have never been arrested. This will continue while serving my reign on the Royal Court.
24. I understand that if I make queen status I will not be able to run again.
25. I understand that I may be removed from my reign at any time that is deemed by the EVCEA that I have violated the above rules.

I have read and understand this agreement for the Royal Court and agree to abide by it. I have received a copy of this agreement.

Ticket Sale Guidelines



You are a representative of the East Valley Community Enhancement Association (EVCEA) and the Moxee Hop Festival. As such, your behavior directly reflects on their reputation.

You are asked to sell tickets for the Moxee Hop Festival Raffle. Tickets are \$1.00 each. You will check out your tickets and will be expected to return the unsold tickets and/or money and tickets

stubs balancing to the amount of tickets you took. Any tickets and/or money not returned will be taken from the percentage you would receive at the end of the contest. Because this is a raffle (Gambling Commission Rules), **ALL** tickets **MUST** be accounted for. They are the same as money; keep them in a safe place. If you ask anyone else to sell for you, be sure you know what tickets numbers she/he has and get the money and stubs, and unsold tickets back.

The candidate selling the most raffle tickets will be the Moxee Hop Festival Queen. She will receive a check for 20% of the total of her ticket sales. The 1st runner-up will receive 15% of her total ticket sale and the remaining candidates will receive 10% of their ticket sales. **A candidate must sell at least \$500.00 in tickets to be eligible to receive any percent of her ticket sales.**

Every effort is made to acquire other prizes but **none** are guaranteed.

The money you make from the raffles is used for the raffle prizes as well as for you, because you do such a terrific job selling tickets, we are able to offer some terrific prizes.

Keep this competition friendly. Neither your advisor nor any else want you hear you complain about what the other girl (s) did or didn't do. If you have a complaint or suggestion, take it to your advisor.

While selling at the Farmer's Market you will be able to bring one adult family member (Mother/Father). **No sister/brothers, friends or boyfriends may accompany you there.** This is your time to greet your public and let them know who you are and what the EVCEA is and why you're selling the tickets.

Suggestions

When selling tickets, ask if the person you approach would like to buy some Moxee Hop Festival tickets. Suggest a book for \$25.00. If they hand you a five dollar bill, hand them five tickets to sign. Don't ask if they want change. If they do, they tell you. ***Remember, if you don't ask, they won't buy.*** When you go to sell tickets, dress nice. Make an extra effort to look "Queenly". If you need help selling, we (EVCEA) have people who would love to help you. Don't take a 'crowd' with you to sell, if you have friends willing to help, spread out. (Be sure you keep track of the tickets, ticket stubs and money).

Do not keep large amounts of money with you. You can turn in any amount of money in to the advisor at **any** time. You can also get more tickets at any time. Your advisor is willing and usually able to meet you for this exchange.
